Heartsaver CPR/AED:

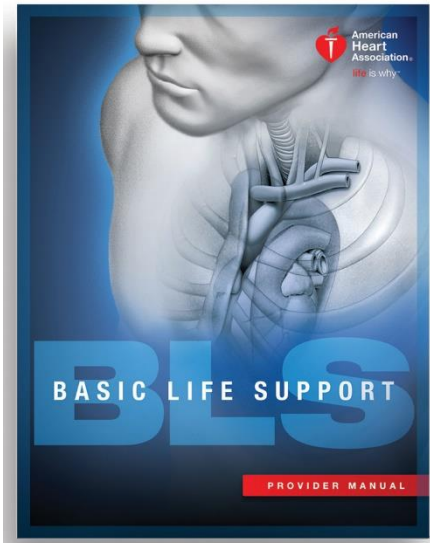


This course is intended for non-medically trained persons wishing to learn how to perform CPR and use an AED in an emergency.

Course content includes CPR, AED usage and choking for Adults, Children and Infants. Students will learn through a combination of Video instruction and hands-on practicals. Our instructor to student ratio provides a comfortable and thorough environment to

ensure every student leaves feeling empowered to act in an emergency.

BLS Provider:



This course is intended for individuals with a medical license or certificate in which CPR certification is required. Course content includes both in-facility and pre-hospital training for single and multiple rescuers, CPR/Defibrillator and team dynamics and choking for adult, child, and infant victims.

****Please note we no longer offer a renewal or "refresher" course. All courses are complete classes.****

Heartsaver First-Aid:



This course is intended for the non-medically trained individual wishing to learn about signs/symptoms and basic first aid. Course content includes signs/symptoms and basic treatment for a wide variety of medical illnesses, bleeding, traumatic injuries, environmental injuries, and bites/stings.

The American Heart Association recognizes the need to differentiate between the adult and pediatric patient. For this reason, we are proud to offer both Adult and Pediatric first aid

courses. The AHA defines a pediatric patient as an individual under the age of roughly 12 or 13.

Blood Borne Pathogens:



This course is intended for any person wishing to learn more about blood Borne pathogens. This course is intended to be a supplemental course for OSHA training in conjunction with the Employer Exposure Control Plan. Stop The Bleed:



This will be offered as a free course held immediately after all HeartSaver CPR/AED courses. The course is FREE and Sponsored by the American College of Surgeons. This course is designed to help the student provide aid in the event of severe traumatic bleeding.
